POSTER PRESENTATION PREPARATION

The Tulsa IEEE will supply 36" x 48" (3' x 4') tri-fold poster board and tape for each project team. These materials will be given to you when you report for the scheduled poster session on April 10^{th} . Prepare PowerPoint printouts for your session. Assuming 8.5 x 11 inch printouts (landscape orientation), you will have room for 16 sheets on your board. We anticipate having 2 poster boards per table. Please tell us any plans to have demonstration apparatus and any special space or power needs.

ORAL PRESENTATION PREPARATION

There will be a computer with PowerPoint available. Each project team will load their presentation on the computer before the start of the scheduled oral presentation session. Flash drives are recommended. Due to a quirk with the facility's computer system, we will preload all of the presentations onto one flash drive before any of the presentations begin. The maximum allowed time is 10 minutes per presentation, plus 5 minutes for questions and transition between presenters. The specific time slot information will be sent to you later.
